Any individual who passes the examination can act as safety guarantor for all construction work in all licence subclasses.

INTRODUCTION TO THE EXAMINATION

The Construction site safety management (CSSM) examination may cover the following subjects:

- · prevention management;
- · management of compensation claim files;
- assessment management;
- statutes and regulations;
- · sustainable development.

To meet the requirements of the subject "Construction site safety management" it is necessary to:

- be informed about the statutes and regulations governing prevention and site inspection;
- know the Commission des normes, de l'équité, de la santé et de la sécurité du travail (CNESST) and its various rules and procedures;
- understand the role of different stakeholders in health and safety;
- know the rights and responsibilities of workers and employers;
- delimit the worksite, monitor the construction site;
- investigate incidents and be able to identify risks;
- integrate sustainable development concepts.

PREPARATION FOR THE EXAMINATION

To prepare for the exam, we recommend that you consult the **competency profile**. It describes all the skills and competencies that are expected of the guarantor and that may be assessed during the examination.
